SAFETY RULES FOR DIATRIM DIAMOND SPINDLE SAWS

Standard Maximum Speeds—10,000 SFPM*

Diatrim #: 53-1 - 38,000 RPM
Diatrim #: 53-112 - 25,000 RPM

Integral Spindle Saw

- 1. The spindle saw mandrel (Spindle) must be inserted to the full depth of the collet.
- 2. Special size mandrels not shown in the Diatrim catalog can be supplied as long as safety regulations are adhered to.
- 3. Work pressure, if excessive, can be the cause of trouble and a source of danger, through bending or fracture of the mandrel. Operator should frequently check spindle wear especially where the spindle meets the blade.
- 4. Safety guards are important to protect the operators as well as others in the immediate area either by containing or deflecting the pieces of an accidently broken blade.
- 5. All grinders should be equipped with dust collection guards if possible. This greatly improves the operators ability to see his saw blade cutting into the work surface.
- 6. Safety goggles, safety spectacles, or face shields should be worn at all times in the grinding areas.
